Judge of Awards

Roy Sumner Johnson, owner and Director of Sumner & Dene, has been in the art business for 43 years. He has owned galleries in Taos, Santa Fe, San Diego and Albuquerque. He was the founding President of the Taos Spring Arts celebration, Director of the Santa Fe Festival of the Arts, and founding executive Director of Magnifico! Albuquerque Festival of the Arts. He taught a college course for 10 years, "The Business of Art", teaching artists how to make a living creating art and working in the arts. He has served on the boards of the Albuquerque Little Theatre, Art in the Schools, Albuquerque Convention and Visitors Bureau (Visit Albuquerque), New Mexico Science Olympiad, Santa Fe Gallery Association, and is the past chair of the Albuquerque Downtown Action Team. Roy created the Give Your Love Art fund-raiser for the New Mexico Aids Services and was the host of the Little Houses Art Auction benefiting OFFcenter. During his tenure with the Albuquerque Art Business Association, Roy was the founder of Local Treasures, served as treasurer, Vice-President and led the charge on the Albuquerque Art Showcase. He holds a BFA from the University of San Francisco with a degree in Advertising and illustration from the San Francisco Academy of Art plus has a self-proclaimed Masters Degree in Gift Wrapping.

Coulter Prehm (b.1984) is an observational painter/ draftsman (works from life) residing in Santa Fe, NM. Colt studied art with many of the top contemporary painters of the day, though the bulk of his study took place with Tony Ryder who is a dear friend, teacher and mentor. His work has been displayed at galleries across the US and has been featured in numerous publications in the United States, Europe and Canada. Colt is an engaging instructor and has taught drawing and painting workshops as well as conducted demos at public universities and other institutions. Peggy Immel was born in Phoenix, Arizona, lived in Boston for over thirty years, and ultimately returned to the west when she and her husband settled in Taos, New Mexico. Her educational background includes architectural studies at Arizona State University and art classes at the School of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston MA, the DeCordova Museum School, Lincoln, MA, and the Silvermine Arts Center, New Canaan, CT. She is a Master Signature Member of Plein Air Painters of New Mexico, a Signature Member of Plein Air Artists Colorado, and a Signature Member of American Women Artists. Peggy's paintings have been included in national exhibitions and have received numerous awards including three Best of Shows and two Trustees' Best of Show Awards at the Millicent Rogers Museum Annual Miniature Exhibition in Taos, NM. Her most recent honors include a First Place for "Grandpa Tied the Flies" at the 2021 Sedona Plein Air Festival, Sedona, AZ, the Artists Choice Award for "Winter Impression" at the 2019 Plein Air Artists Colorado National Juried Exhibition and a Best of Signature Members for "Pink and Blue" at the 2020 Plein Air Artists Colorado National Juried Exhibition. Her work has been showcased in Santa Fean Magazine, Fine Art Connoisseur Magazine, Plein Air Magazine, Southwest Art, and Art of the West Magazine. She is represented by Wilder Nightingale Fine Art in Taos, NM and Sorrel Sky Gallery in Santa Fe, NM and Durango, CO.



Juror of Selection

Peggy Trigg uses loose, strong brush strokes, laying color over color to create depth and texture. She most often works using a spatula or a large brush to apply primarily oils and works on both archival birch panels and canvas. Peggy Trigg's love for the land springs from being raised in the country near Cerrillos and later Las Vegas. She currently lives north of Taos, hiking and painting the land that is her home. Her artwork can be seen at numerous locations including La Mesa Gallery on Canyon Road in Santa Fe, Wilder Nightingale Fine Arts in Taos and Romero's Gallery in Albuquerque. She also shows seasonally at the beautiful gallery in Dixon called Mitier. Her website, peggytrigg.com offers a large database of work and a secure online shopping experience. Her work is also in seven permanent Public Arts locations in New Mexico and in Sasebo, Japan. Her work has been reviewed in numerous publications including The Outdoor Painter and Southwest Art Magazine.
