Her professional credits for acting and directing include work at Berkeley Shakespeare Festival, Theater Rhinoceros, Alice B. Theatre, Book-It Repertory Theatre, Samuel French Off Off Broadway Festival, Northwest Asian American Theatre, On the Boards, A Contemporary Theatre, Southwest Repertory Theatre, The Provincetown Tennessee Williams Festival,

Berkeley Stage Company, The Empty Space, and Bay Area Playwrights Festival. Her most recent work has been directing the staged reading *Speak Truth to Power* at the ABQ Museum as well as the mainstage production of Tennessee Williams' *The Two-Character Play*.

TIFFANY COLE joined the FUSION family when she performed in *Campaigns, Chainsaws, and Chocolate Milk* in *The Seven Short Works Festival*. Tiffany's favorite theatre credits include her "hauntingly vivacious" turn as Fefu in *Fefu and Her Friends* (Charles McNulty's 'Top 10 [National] Productions of 2019' at the Odyssey Theatre), the award-winning productions of *Punch & Judy* (LA Drama Critic's Circle) and *Very Still & Hard to See* (LA Weekly Award), as

well as the "perfectly enraged" titular role in *Electra*. A former faculty member at the USC School of Dramatic Arts, her notable film-work includes *Sharknado* (you read that correctly!) and *The Last Girl*, as well as *True Blue* and *Park 33*, both currently in the festival circuit, and *SOS-Paperclip*, a short film that she co-wrote and directed.

KANE DISTLER has appeared on the FUSION stage in *The Seven, The 2nd Seven, The NM Seven, Hotel Cassiopeia*, and *The Real Inspector Hound*. He performed in Port 66's monthly melodrama, *Feral, Minnesota*. Kane studied stage management at UNCW while working as a technician and stage manager in both North Carolina and Maryland. Alongside his career, he returned to the stage in 2016 as Jason/Tyrone in UNCW's production of *Hand to God*

and as Deidre in *Good Kids*. He has also appeared on screen as Mr. J in Vera Drew's indie feature film, *The People's Joker*, which premiered at the 2022 Toronto International Film Festival. On other Albuquerque stages, Kane has appeared in Tricklock Company's *Strange as it Seems*; Duke City Repertory Theatre's *No Holds Bard* (2020) and *Bard Crawl: A Midsummer Night's Dream* (2023); and UNM's *Linnel Festival of New Plays* (2022–23).



WENDY SCOTT is delighted to be joining FUSION on the main stage! Wendy has performed in *The Seven* for eleven years, and further productions with FUSION include *The Moors*, *August: Osage County*, *How the Other Half Loves*, and *Death of a Salesman*. Wendy is a BFA graduate of the UNM Theatre Arts Program and has completed her studies as a pastry chef at the Seattle Culinary Academy. Her film and TV credits include *Better Call Saul*, *Breaking Bad*, *Duality*, *M v W*,

and *Dead Billy*. Wendy works in the Rio Rancho Public Schools as a teaching artist and project manager with The Santa Fe Opera's ALTO program.

KATE HAMILL (Playwright) is an award-winning NYC-based actor/ playwright. She is deeply passionate about creating new feminist, female-centered classics, both in new plays and in adaptation: stories that center around complicated women. Her work as a playwright celebrates theatricality, often features absurdity, and closely examines social and gender issues - as well as the timeless struggle to reconcile conscience / identity with social pressures. As an actor, she tends to play truth-tellers, oddballs, and misfits. Kate was named 2017's Playwright of the Year by the Wall Street Journal. She has been one of the 10 most-produced playwrights in the country, 3 seasons running (2017-2020); in both 2017-2018 and 2018-2019, she wrote two of the top 10 most produced plays in the U.S.; many of her plays have been produced internationally.

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
